

RULE 69

PROCEEDINGS UNDER THE *ADULT GUARDIANSHIP AND TRUSTEESHIP ACT*

PROCEDURE

- 69.01** Proceedings in the Supreme Court relating to the capacity, or lack thereof, of a person shall be taken in accordance with the *Adult Guardianship and Trusteeship Act*, but these rules, with necessary modifications, shall apply to such proceedings except to the extent of any inconsistency with the said statute.
- 69.02** In addition to the items outlined in the *Adult Guardianship and Trusteeship Act*, and any regulations made thereto, accounts filed with the Prothonotary under the legislation shall include such other information that the Prothonotary requires.
- 69.03** In passing the accounts, the Prothonotary may cause parties to be examined, and to produce books, papers and writings, as the Prothonotary thinks fit and may determine what books, papers and writings are to be produced, and where and how long they are to be left with the Prothonotary or the court.
- 69.04** The Prothonotary has the authority to order a guardian, personal representative, or trustee to undertake an audit, or to directly order that an audit be undertaken, of the accounts by a qualified person or firm and filed with the court.
- 69.05** In addition to rendering true and correct accounts of the person under disability in accordance with the *Adult Guardianship and Trusteeship Act*, the Prothonotary or the court may also require the personal representative to pass its accounts.
