



Notice to the Profession, the Public and the Media regarding court operations, Covid-19

P.E.I. Court of Appeal and Supreme Court of P.E.I.

June 15, 2022

Beginning June 30, 2022, the Supreme Court and Court of Appeal will be lifting Covid-19 restrictions which have been in place to date.

Masks

The courts will no longer require masks to be worn by those who enter the courthouse.

Gathering Limits

All gathering and capacity limits implemented during the Covid-19 pandemic will be lifted. As a result, it will no longer be necessary to advise the court clerk in advance the names and contact information for individuals who will be attending a court proceeding.

Filing Documents

Access to the Registry will no longer be restricted. The Drop Box will continue to be available for document delivery, and you are encouraged to use this alternative. The option of filing documents via email to scfiling@courts.pe.ca will also be maintained, subject to limitations relating to voluminous filings and any filings which are bound and/or tabbed.

Thank you to all for your cooperation during the restrictions which have been in place over these past two years.
