

Notice to the Profession, the Public and the Media regarding Court Operations during CPHO COVID-19 "Circuit Breaker"

Prince Edward Island Court of Appeal, Supreme Court and Provincial Court

December 7, 2020

The Prince Edward Island Courts follow the directions of the Chief Public Health Officer (CPHO) necessitated by this pandemic, and strive to maintain court operations. To protect the health and safety of the public and court staff, the following adjustments will be made to court operations. These changes are effective today and will continue in place (subject to further notice) until December 31st.

In order to avoid public interaction, in-person attendances will be minimized. As much as possible, cases and matters will be heard virtually, unless otherwise determined by the presiding judge.

Previous hearing directives – regarding virtual hearings, court filings, mask wearing – all published on the P.E.I. courts' website, remain in effect.

In the Provincial Court, access to a proceeding continues to be restricted to only those persons whose presence is necessary. This includes counsel, accused, witnesses, support workers, probation officers, court officers and members of the media, or such other persons as authorized <u>in advance</u> by the judge.
